Overview of Programs in Fiscal Year 2025


Operations:

Freedom Hill Horse Rescue (FHHR) is a 501(c)(3) non-profit that operates out of the beautiful grounds at Hampton Manor in Owings, MD, with three pastures (3-4 acres each), 6 paddocks, an outdoor arena, a 10-stall barn, and a 2-stall “small” barn. FHHR also has access to a satellite barn for quarantine of new horses or overflow purposes. FHHR currently cares for nine horses: eight program/sanctuary horses. There is currently one adoptable horse being fostered off-site.

In 2025, Freedom Hill Horse Rescue...


- Hosted 16 events and programs

- Logged over 10,341 volunteer hours
- Rescued 1 new horse
- had 15 angels sponsor our horses

- was visited by over 500 visitors to our facility
- assisted 21 horses and their owners by finding them new homes
